

Directions to Tatham Fells Church and Old School

The Old School is behind the Church, and accessed through the churchyard. All vehicle routes finish the same way, down a narrow lane to the church gates. The Church car park is through a wooden field gate just before the church gates. To reach the Old School, which has its own small car park, go through the church gates, and follow the track through another gate and the churchyard.

Nearest post code is LA2 8PS; you will need the directions below for the last bit!

From south-west (Lancaster via Wray)

- In Wray village, turn R off B6480 onto main village street (signed Tatham Fells, Lowgill)
- Keep following the most obvious road, and Lowgill signs.
- 2½ miles from Wray, turn right (signed Lowgill; bus shelter on right)
- 1.2 miles, then fork L (signed Slaidburn, Burnmoor - ignore L turn signed White Pits)
- Keep going exactly ½ mile to prominent sign **Church / Old School ½**
- Turn R down the signposted lane to reach the church gates

From north-west (Kirkby Lonsdale)

- Follow A65 east until, as you approach Ingleton, turn R onto A687 (Country Harvest shop/café by junction on R)
- Follow 2 miles to Burton-in-Lonsdale and turn L just after shop on R, and village hall on L
- Follow 1½ miles to Low Bentham
- At T junction turn R onto B6480
- After going under railway bridge, and IMMEDIATELY after Punchbowl Inn on L, turn L
- After 1.1 miles, turn L (bus shelter by junction) onto Fairheath Road (signed Lowgill)
- 1.2 miles, then fork L (signed Slaidburn, Burnmoor - ignore L turn signed White Pits)
- Keep going exactly ½ mile to prominent sign **Church / Old School ½**
- Turn R down the signposted lane to reach the church gates

From east (Skipton, Settle)

- Follow A65 west to just past Clapham
- Turn L onto B6480 (signed Bentham)
- Follow B6480 for 5 miles to High Bentham
- In middle of High Bentham, turn L just after the Co-op (on R) by the Black Bull (on L) onto Station Road
- Follow this road for 2 miles, downhill at first, over rail and river bridges, then mostly uphill.
- 200 yards after crossing into Lancashire, and just after the crest of the hill, turn R.
- After ¼ mile, the road forks; keep L, across a cattle grid.
- Follow lane for 1.2 miles to prominent sign **Church / Old School ½**
- Turn L down the signposted lane to reach the church gates
